By her own admission, Sonia Amelio, in her international tours, strives, in addition to achieving purely artistic goals, to bring a message of unity, peace, brotherhood and love. Beginning her career in helping to pacify a conflict in her native Mexico in 1994, she has continued to pursue her "crusade of art for peace" and for many years has taken up the appeal for mutual understanding between various peoples of the earth. She describes herself as "a ballerina of peace and love."

The concerts included a video presentation of her artistic life and her tours and appearances on various continents of the world.

EUROPEAN UNION TO CONDUCT BAKU CULTURAL HERITAGE FESTIVAL



On the occasion of the European Year of Cultural Heritage, the Delegation of the European Union to Azerbaijan in cooperation with the Embassies of EU Member States and in particular Germany, France, Greece, Poland, Croatia, the Netherlands, Hungary will organize the First "Fantazia" Festival aimed at raising awareness about the importance of preserving cultural heritage in Baku and Azerbaijan. The Embassies of Mexico, Moldova and Morocco are also participating. United Cultures will provide organizational support under a contract financed by the European Union.

Fantazia Festival will be held in Baku from **1 to 10 November 2018** and will present a diverse calendar of events, including concerts, guided tours, workshops, film screenings, exhibitions, art installations, competitions and debates with internationally and locally acclaimed experts. During the Festival, the emphasis will be on the area of the Icheri Sheher, former "Sovetskaya" area and the neighborhood around "Fantazia" hamam, the latter was taken also as a name for the Festival. The famous "Fantazia" hamam was built in the end of the 19th century and brought together European architecture with local specific elements.

The Festival is supported by "The Landmark". Official partners of the initiative are: State Tourism Agency, Union of Architects, Administration of the State Historical-Architectural Reservation "Icheri Sheher", Azerbaijan Carpet Museum, "Maksud Ibrahimbeyov" Creative Centre, "Yarat" Contemporary Art Center. Scientific partners are: Ca' Foscari University of Venice, ADA University, Azerbaijani French University, Azerbaijan National University of Culture and Arts, Azerbaijan University of Architecture and Construction.

TIRAMISU



Tiramisu is a coffee-flavoured Italian dessert. It is made of ladyfingers dipped in coffee, layered with a whipped mixture of eggs, sugar, and mascarpone cheese, flavored with cocoa. The recipe has been adapted into many varieties of cakes and other desserts. Its origins are often disputed among Italian regions of Veneto, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Piedmont, and others.

Instructions:

1. In 2-quart saucepan, beat egg yolks and sugar with wire whisk until well mixed. Beat in milk. Heat to boiling over medium heat, stirring constantly; reduce heat to low. Boil and stir 1 minute; remove from heat. Pour into medium bowl; place plastic wrap directly onto surface of custard mixture. Refrigerate about 1 hour or until chilled.

2. Add cheese to custard mixture. Beat with electric mixer on medium speed until smooth; set aside.

3. In chilled medium bowl, beat whipping cream and vanilla with electric mixer on high speed until stiff; set aside. In small bowl, mix espresso and rum.

4. Separate ladyfingers horizontally; brush with espresso mixture (do not soak). In ungreased 11x7-inch glass baking dish, arrange half of the ladyfingers in single layer. Spread half of the cheese mixture over ladyfingers; spread with half of the whipped cream. Repeat layers with remaining ladyfingers, cheese mixture and whipped cream. Sprinkle with cocoa. Refrigerate at least 4 to 6 hours to develop flavors but no longer than 24 hours. Store covered in refrigerator.

Ingredients:

- 6 Large egg yolks
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 2/3 cup milk
- 1lb mascarpone cheese or 2 packages (8 oz each) cream cheese, softened
- 1 1/4 cups whipping (heavy) cream
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/4 cup brewed espresso or very strong coffee, chille
- 2 tablespoons rum*
- 2 packages (3 oz each) ladyfingers**
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking cocoa

INTERVIEW WITH ZAUR KARIMOV DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF AMCHAM

Q: As AmCham is based in the Landmark premises since 2007, what is your main experience here?
